# Brannock and Patek's Harvest Home

Size: Finished quilt measures 84" x 96"

## Fabrics:

Fabric #1 – Green Large Floral – 2¼ yds.

Fabric #2 – Black Large Floral – 3¾ yds.

*Note: Yardage includes border and binding.*

Fabric #3 – Green Print – ⅞ yd.

Fabric #4 – Green Print – ⅞ yd.

Fabric #5 – Green Print – ⅞ yd.

Fabric #6 – Green Print – ⅞ yd.

Fabric #7 – Red Print – ½ yd.

Fabric #8 – Red Print – ½ yd.

Fabric #9 – Red Print – ½ yd.

Fabric #10 – Red Print – ⅝ yd.

Fabric #11 – Gold Print – ⅛ yd.

Fabric #12 – Gold Print – ⅛ yd.

Fabric #13 – Black Print – ⅛ yd.

Fabric #14 – Black Print – ⅛ yd.

Fabric #15 – Light Print – ⅜ yd.

Fabric #16 – Light Print – ⅜ yd.

Fabric #17 – Light Print – ⅜ yd.

Fabric #18 – Light Print – ⅜ yd.

Fabric #19 – Light Print – ⅜ yd.

Fabric #20 – Light Print – ⅜ yd.

Backing – 6 yds.

## Cutting Directions:

*To avoid mix-ups we suggest that you label each group of cut pieces.*

Fabric #1 – Green Large Floral cut:

8 strips, 9½" x WOF

Subcut 30 squares 9½" x 9½"

Fabric #2 – Black Large Floral cut:

6 strips, 5" x WOF

Subcut: 22 rectangles 5" x 9½"

4 squares, 5" x 5" for corner squares

8 strips, 2½" x WOF for Star Point strip sets

9 strips, 6½" x WOF for **Border**

10 strips, 2¼" x WOF for **Binding**

Fabric #3 – Green print cut:

12 strips – 2½" WOF for Star Point strip sets

Fabric #'s 4, 5, 6 – Green Prints cut:

10 strips of each print

2½" WOF for Star Point strip sets

Fabric #'s 7, 8, 9 – Red prints cut:

6 strips of each print

2½" x WOF for Star Point strip sets

Fabric #10 – Red print, cut:

7 strips, 2½" x WOF for Star Point strip sets

Fabric #'s 15, 16, 18, 19, 20 – Light prints, cut:

4 strips of each print

2½" x WOF for Star Point strip sets

1 strip each 2" x WOF for 4-patch strip sets

Fabric #17 – Light print, cut:

5 strips 2½" x WOF for Star Point strip sets

1 strip each 2" x WOF for 4-patch strip sets

Fabric #'s 13, 14 – Black prints cut:

1 strip each 2" x WOF for 4-patch strip sets

Fabric #'s 11, 12 – Gold prints cut:

1 strip each 2" x WOF for 4-patch strip sets

## Quilter Basics:

☞ Read instructions before beginning a project.

☞ All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance.

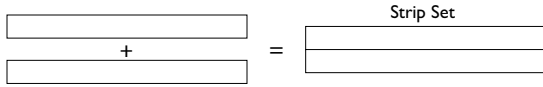
☞ Label each group of cut pieces.

☞ Press as you go. Press seams in one direction toward the darker fabric whenever possible.

# Construction:

## STAR POINTS

**1. STRIP SETS.** Sew pairs of strips together lengthwise in the quantity and color combination listed below. Press seams toward darker fabric.



**3. FROM THE 4 STRIP SETS OF FABRIC #2** (black large floral print) combined with Fabrics #7, 8, 9, 10, (reds), cut 14 template shapes in Position X AND 14 shapes in Position O. (See Diagram A)  
Cut some of both positions from each strip set.

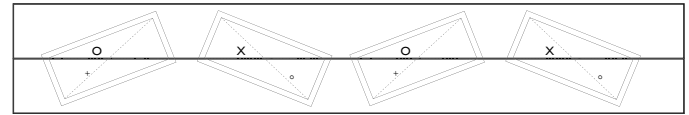

Select pairs of X's and O's and sew with Fabric #2 sides together. To create a scrappy look, be sure that pairs do not match in fabric combinations. (See Diagram B).

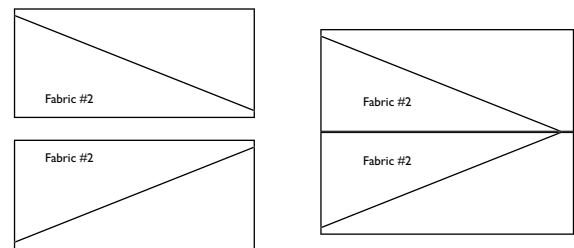

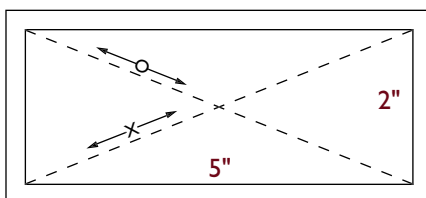
**4. FROM THE 21 STRIP SETS OF FABRIC #'S 3, 4, 5, 6** (greens) combined with Fabric #'s 7, 8, 9, 10 (reds), cut 71 template shapes in Position X and 71 shapes in Position O. Cut some of both positions from each strip set. Select pairs of X's and O's and sew with green fabric sides together in the same method as above.

**5. FROM THE 4 STRIP SETS OF FABRIC #2** (black large floral print) combined with Fabrics #15, 16, 17, 18 (lights), cut 14 template shapes in Position X and 14 shapes in Position O. Cut some of both positions from each strip set. Select pairs of X's and O's and sew with Fabric #2 sides together in the same method as above.

**6. FROM THE 21 STRIP SETS OF FABRIC #'S 3, 4, 5, 6** (greens) combined with Fabric #'s 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 (lights), cut 71 template shapes in Position X and 71 shapes in Position O. Cut some of both positions from each strip set. Select pairs of X's and O's and sew with green sides together in the same method as above.

COMBINATION OF FABRICS	NUMBER OF PAIRS
One #2 and one each of #7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18	Total of 8 strip sets
One #3 and one each of #7, 8, 9, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20	Total of 8 strip sets
One # 3 and two each of #10 and #17	Total of 4 strip sets
One #4 and one each of #7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20	Total of 10 strip sets
One #5 and one each of #7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20	Total of 10 strip sets
One #6 and one each of #19, 20	Total of 2 strip sets
One #6 and two each of #7, 8, 9, 10	Total of 8 strip sets

**2. MAKE A TEMPLATE** by drawing a 2"x5" rectangle on transparent material such as vellum, tracing paper, mylar, or transparency sheet. Draw a second rectangle within the first, 1/4" from all sides. Draw a dotted diagonal line on the interior rectangle from corner to corner in both directions. This dotted line will align with the strip set seam line. Mark Position X and O on the indicated lines. Mark Position X and O on the indicated lines.

## FOUR PATCH

**1. STRIP SETS.** Sew pairs of strips together lengthwise in the same method as Star Point instruction. Follow the combinations given below.

- Fabric #13 (Black print) and Fabric #11 (Gold)
- Fabric #14 (Black print) and Fabric #12 (Gold)
- Fabric #15 (Light print) and Fabric #16 (Light print)
- Fabric #17 (Light print) and Fabric #18 (Light print)
- Fabric #19 (Light print) and Fabric #20 (Light print)

**2. PRESS SEAMS TOWARD DARKER FABRIC.**

*Note: Width of sewn unit should measure 3½".*

**3. CUT EACH SEWN UNIT INTO 2" SEGMENTS.** Sew pairs together, alternating fabric position, to form 4-patches. Make 21 black with gold and 21 light with light.

*(See Diagram D)*



## Assemble Quilt:

**1. ARRANGE ALL SQUARES,** rectangles, 4-patch units, Star Point units as shown. Sew all Star Point units together that appear horizontally and vertically. Refer to the illustration. Place them back in the quilt piece arrangement. Sew pieces and sewn units together in horizontal rows. Then sew rows together.

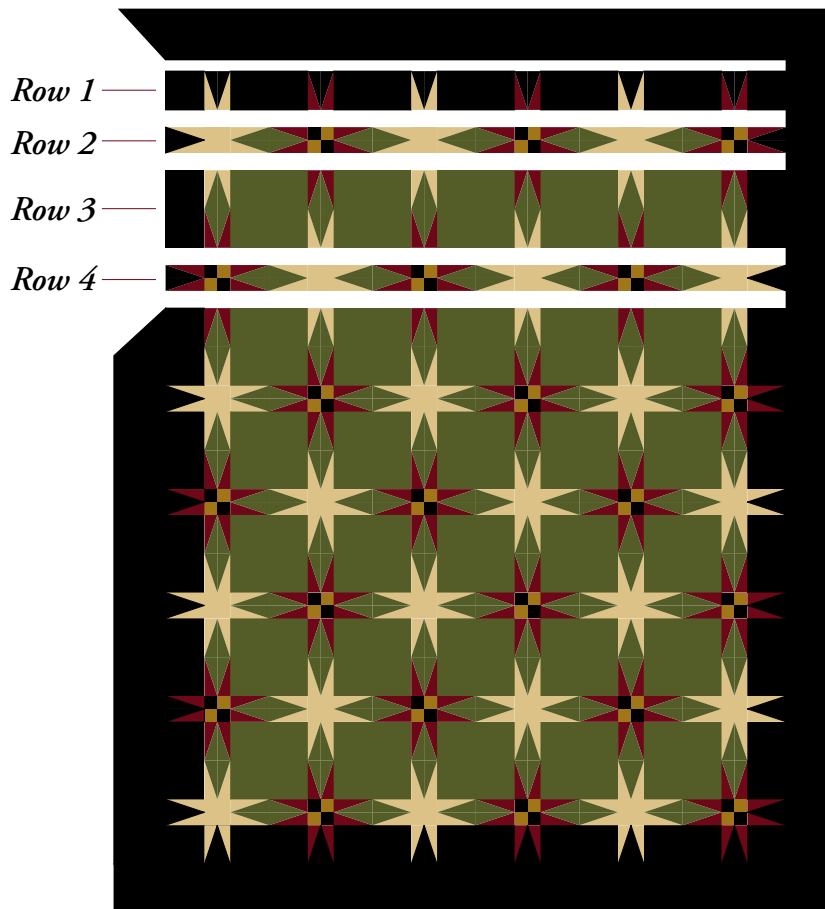
**2. PIECE AND CUT BORDER STRIPS.** To determine the length of the side borders, measure the quilt top through the vertical center. Cut 2 border strips to this measurement, piecing and trimming strips when needed to attain the required length.

Mark the center of the border strips and the sides of the quilt top with pins.

With right sides together, pin the border strips to the quilt top matching center pins and ends. Stitch the borders to the quilt top. Press the seams toward the border.

Repeat steps for top and bottom borders. Press.

**Quilt** as desired.
